Dear Thomas A. Edison High School Families,

This letter is to inform you of an incident that occurred at our school yesterday and outline the steps we are taking to heal as a school community. During the school day, tensions prompted a fight, which caused commotion and movement in the hallway during our classroom transition. This caused a chain reaction of arguments leading to more than forty students involved in altercations. As a result, the school was placed on lockdown for about 20 minutes and the members of the Philadelphia Police Department were onsite to provide support for de-escalation.

Let me be clear that this behavior will not be tolerated in our school. In response, we will have 3 additional full-time and 2 part-time climate staff members onsite and have restructured administrative supports to maintain a safe school environment. Today, we engaged in mediation and will have a town hall with all students and as we begin to heal our school-wide community climate.
